Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the budget commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and, certifying them to the County fiscal officer for 2016, and declaring an emergency.

Mrs. Greer motioned to set aside the Three Reading Rule, and Mrs. Dilworth seconded the motion.

Roll Call: Mrs. Godwin, Mr. McDaniel, Mrs. Greer, Mr. Goch, Ms. Dilworth all voted Aye, and the motion passed.

Mrs. Greer motioned to adopt Resolution R-16.41, second by Mr. McDaniel.


Discussion: Mrs. Greer asked if someone would explain why the need for the special meeting to pass this piece of legislation occurred. Fiscal Officer, Leah Weirick, explained that during the period of time when there was a vacancy of the Fiscal Officer position, an email was missed that was sent by the County. The County called yesterday and said they didn't have this legislation and it was needed prior to the end of the year.
